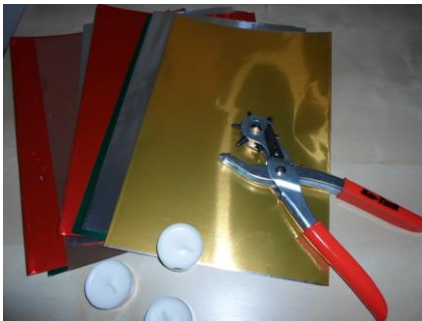


How to Make Funky Little Tetrahedron Christmas Candle Holders!



You'll need:



- Some sheets of thin metal (from craft shops or websites)
- A hole punch (a craft/leather punch can be adjusted to make different sized holes)
- Template ([click here for template](#))
- Tea lights
- Scissors
- Wire for hanging (optional)

Place the template onto a metal sheet and using a ruler and pen or pencil, trace the shape of the triangle and the dotted score lines onto the metal by pressing through the paper so that it etches into the metal.

Cut out the triangle and fold along the score lines. Use a hole punch to make holes in the sides. You can also use a pen on the reverse side of the metal sheet to etch a design into the sides of the candle holder.

Fold up the sides and put a candle inside. Light it and then fold the sides up completely to enclose the candle.

To create a hanging candle holder, punch a hole in the top of each triangle then use wire to thread through the holes and create a loop
